Their women's shelter accommodates approximately 28 women and the men's shelter can accommodate approximately 40 men. They ensure that each guest has a place to sleep in comfort and security. Upon arrival, everyone receives freshly laundered sheets, blankets, and access to clean showers and scrubs.
