There are four **Low-Income Housing Tax Credit** (LIHTC) properties in the City of Amarillo which provide subsidized rent to older adults based on their income. These properties are:

- **Bivins Village**
- **Independence Village**
- **Northwest Village**
- **Winwood Village**

These complexes may also offer additional onsite services which benefit older adults and individuals with disabilities including FoodNET meals served Monday - Friday (see Potter and Randall County Resource pages for more info). Find their contact information online or on the list the AAA provides.
